There are four phases to the volunteer process with RAV:

- Before onboarding, volunteers will be asked to complete an application, background check and interview.
- Upon acceptance into the RAV volunteer pool, candidates will be matched with the most appropriate opportunity.
- During the service experience, volunteers will learn more about RAV, receive vital training skills, and updates on their progress.
- After the volunteer commitment period ends, participants will share feedback on their experiences, garner meaningful interactions with community members, and receive community service hours and/or a letter of recommendation.

### Close the Learning Gap

Volunteers serve as tutors and mentors, also known as Driven Student Guides, to K-8 students as part of the Driven 2 Succeed, homework help program.

### Assist with Office Tasks

Volunteers assist staff with essential office tasks such as mailings, merchandising, and marketing campaigns. Office tasks performed by our volunteers are essential to RAV's daily operations.

### Promote the Organization

Volunteers assist our public outreach team at various local and promotional events by enthusiastically engaging with guests, distributing collateral materials, and representing Raising A Village as an ambassador in the community.

## Join a network committed to build safe, healthy, and whole communities

Volunteer eligibility requirements include:

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Be willing to adhere to all RAV policies and procedures
- Commit to serving a minimum of eight hours per month
- Agree to attend trainings as required
- Be willing to communicate regularly with the RAV staff and submit monthly reporting documents
- Have access to an automobile or reliable transportation
- Be able to pass a background check
- Adhere to our policy of no alcohol or controlled substance usage while serving in an official RAV capacity
- Complete appropriate screening procedures
